- 3) All stamps submitted for perforating must be printed on ungummed or dry-gummed paper. Self-adhesive papers and stickers will be returned unperforated.
- 4) Official (government-issued) stamps and reproductions thereof, as well as stamps promoting illegal or immoral activities, will be returned unperforated.
